

2025 SUMMER HIGH SCHOOL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Interested in volunteering this summer? Submit an application and recommendation form to apply for our program.

Important Information

The link to the application and recommendation form for the 2025 Summer High School Volunteer Program will be available on the Nemours Children's Health website (Nemours.org/volunteering). **The application is ONLY open from February 14 – 28, 2025**. We must receive the student's application and recommendation form by 4 PM on February 28, 2025, to be considered for the program. The number of students accepted depends on the number of positions available at the time, hospital guidelines, and various other conditions. We may need to modify this summer's program if there are any circumstances impacting the program. We expect that the number of applications submitted will exceed the volunteer positions we will have available, so new participants will be selected by a lottery.

Program Guidelines

- Program Dates: Monday, June 16 through Friday, August 8, 2024
- Must be 16 years old by June 16, 2025, and have completed sophomore year
- Program is 8-weeks long. Students must fulfill the minimum commitment: 7 of the 8 weeks
- With prior approval, students will be permitted one week off
- Will be scheduled for one day per week, Monday through Thursday, a few Friday positions may be available.
- Must be able to volunteer from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. one day a week. Students will be scheduled for a morning shift, eat lunch, and then have an afternoon shift.
- Once established, the student's schedule will remain constant throughout the session

Requirements of the Program

- Must submit a completed 2025 Summer High School Volunteer Program Application and a Recommendation Form that must be filled out and submitted by a teacher or a guidance counselor
- Must attend a mandatory online information session with a parent/guardian on either March 4 or 7 from 5:50 -6:30 pm.
- If selected from the lottery, the student must sign up and attend a mandatory interview/information session- April 8 from 4-7 pm, April 9 from 4-7 pm, or April 12 from 9 am noon

If Accepted

- Must submit immunization proof of Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR), Varicella, TDAP and proof of two recent TB tests or a TB blood test
- Must complete online training
- Must submit the required forms
- Must pass background checks if 18 or older
