## Here's what to bring to your first visit.

- List of Current Medical Providers**  
Include all pediatricians, specialists and therapists who have seen your child in the last 18 months, along with their contact information so we can reach out if we need additional information.
- Clinical Summary**  
Your child's current pediatrician and/or specialists can provide this brief medical history and explanation of the care provided to your child.
- List of Medications**  
List ALL medications your child currently takes, the dosage for each one, and the pharmacy contact information. Include prescribed medications, over-the-counter medications, vitamins, supplements, formula or enteral feeds. To avoid running out of a medication, please have at least a 30-day supply on hand.
- Immunization Record**  
List all vaccines your child has received. If your child has not been fully vaccinated, please bring a completed Health Department exemption form.
- Relevant Diagnostic Test Results**  
Provide copies of lab results, medical imaging (X-rays, MRIs, CT scans, ultrasounds, etc.), and genetic testing. Be sure to identify who performed the test so we can request additional information if needed.
- Education Status**  
If your child has a current IEP or psychoeducational evaluation report please bring a copy. We will also want to know if you have home school placement needs or if your child attends a charter school or special-needs school.
- List of Homecare Needs and Supplies**  
Please provide a home health plan of care that details the supplies you currently use. Examples of home care needs are diapers, oxygen and G-tubes.
- List of Durable Medical Equipment (DME)**  
Please list all medical equipment used by your child. If you are moving, if possible bring your critical DME with you instead of putting it on the moving truck as shipments can be delayed.
- Medical Insurance Information**  
Please bring your child's medical insurance information.
